OPEN BURNING, RECREATIONAL FIRES AND PORTABLE OUTDOOR FIREPLACES International Fire Code Chapter 3 Sec. 307

PROHIBITED BURNING:	Open burning shall be prohibited when atmospheric conditions and local circumstances make such fires hazardous.
ADA COUNTY DEQ:	Call: ADA County Department of Environmental Quality for clear burn days. 208-373-0313 <u>http://www.deq.idaho.gov/air-quality/monitoring/daily-reports- and-forecasts.aspx</u>
PERMIT:	No permits required, follow DEQ requirements.
EXTINGUISHING AUTHORITY:	Where open burning creates or adds to a hazardous situation. The Fire Code Official is authorized to order the extinguishment of the open burning.
BONFIRES OPEN BURNING:	50 feet from any structure or combustible material unless contained to a barbecue pit. Conditions that would cause the fire to spread within 50 of structure shall be eliminated.
RECREATIONAL FIRES:	25 feet from any structure or combustible material. Materials within 25 feet from a structure shall be removed. Pile size 3 feet diameter and maximum 2 feet in height.
PORTABLE OUTDOOR FIRE PLACES:	Shall be used according to manufacture listing. No listing, shall not be withing 15 feet of structure.
ATTENDANCE:	Shall be constantly attended until fire is extinguished.
EXTINGUISHING:	Shall have a source of extinguishment available on-site i.e. Fire extinguisher, water hose or barrel, dirt, sand or water-truck
